

## **Trustee Meeting Minutes**

### **Old Business;**

- Remodel of main hallway bathrooms are complete.
- Basketts have moved out of the parsonage and Vineyards have now moved in.
- Roofing leaks (not all of them) have been fixed.
- Ceiling tile replacement will be postponed until roofing leaks have been fixed.
- Painting of the splatter class room will probably be done on the church work day.

- Den screen door – Ernie will be going to wysong to see if it can be fixed.
- Light switch in kitchen – to be replaced.
- Ceiling fan in MBR – purchased but not installed yet.
- Ceiling fan in office – purchased but not installed yet.
- Cabinet doors under the sink – Robert Frosch to take a look at.
- Wall stops for several doors –will be purchased from Sun Valley Hardware and installed by Ernie.
- Light fixture above sink – to be purchase by Ernie.
- Towel racks for 2<sup>nd</sup> bath room – to be gotten at Sun Valley and put in by Ernie.
- Clean duct work – 3 chips was contacted and will clean duct work next week.
