

## Giving Electronically

Perhaps you enjoy writing your check each week or month; perhaps not. Perhaps you wish there was a way to simplify the giving process, similar to the automatic bill-pay feature provided by many companies.

There is such an equivalent! And you may enroll today, using the form at right, in this direct-debit program to simplify your life!

The United Methodist Church has endorsed a plan whereby you may authorize Vanco Services LLC to debit your checking or savings account weekly or monthly and to deposit those funds directly into the church's bank account. No check to write, no memory lapses, no regrets while vacationing. You specify the amount to be debited and you may change the amount *whenever you wish*.



Some members of the church already give electronically and enjoy less-stress tithing-giving. Why don't you join that stress-reduced group?

### Frequently Asked Questions

#### What is eGiving?

eGiving is a service to prioritize your giving via a secure electronic transfer of funds from your checking or savings account directly into the church's account. It is also known as Electronic Funds Transfer (EFT), Automated Clearing House (ACH) transfer, direct payment, automatic bill payment, or automated debit and electronic payment.

#### How will you know the amount and date of deduction from your account?

The amount and timing will be exactly as specified on this enrollment form (or the next business day thereafter) and will continue until you change it.

The debit will appear on the statement from your financial institution.

#### How does the church benefit from the eGiving program?

Considerable volunteer time is spent each week/month counting the giving amount, preparing the bank deposit, and crediting your giving record.

eGiving eliminates some of this process, minimizes opportunity for errors, and preserves the privacy of your giving. Plus, the church receives a predictable cash inflow.

#### How will you benefit from the eGiving program?

You decide what to give on the **FIRST** of each week or **FIRST** of each month. Giving to God **FIRST** becomes a priority via your intentional decision to eGive.

#### What will this cost me?

Nothing! The church will pay the small enrollment and transaction fees.
