

Mission Committee Minutes

Ed called the meeting to order with prayer;

Ed had sent the minutes to everyone and there were no objections to them.

Ed asked if anyone liked to write. No one said that they did. He is looking for someone to write about the Bread basket offerings for the newsletter. Other things could be written about as well.

This Sunday, Barbara will talk about the form the committee is asking others (committees, members, etc.) to fill out in the church about what they are doing in the church. The form was designed by Marge and will be on the back table in the sanctuary for everyone to pick up after the service.

Barbara would like the Bread basket offering to happen earlier in the service so will talk to Ernie about it.

Ed has a long list of potential Bread basket offerings. He asked what process we should use to decide which ones we would give to. A long discussion then took place about what constitutes a Bread basket offering, the ones we have to give to, and the ones that are already in place. It was decided to go by the list of offerings already in place, 12 required offerings, one each month. Offerings could be added to these is necessary. Ed will type up the list of 12 for each of the committee members and we will go from there if still necessary.
